Scholarship Application Instructions

1. Scholarships up to \$1000 will be awarded for both the fall and spring semesters.
2. To be eligible for this scholarship, you must be a family member of a current member of the New Mexico Vegetation Management Association, or you may join the Association.
3. Submit the application with a copy of your high school transcripts if you are an entering freshman or a copy of your college or university transcripts if you are a continuing or transfer student by February 1 and September 1 based on spring or fall application, to the following address:

4. A committee of the members of the NM Vegetation Management Association will review all of the applications based upon completeness and merit of application and scholastic achievement.
5. Preference will be given to students studying for a degree in agriculture, biology, weed science, chemistry or natural resources at a New Mexico University/College.
6. Preference will be given to students that have completed at least one year of course work toward their degree.
7. Preference will be given to students who have maintained a GPA of 3.0 or higher during their past year of studies.
8. The recipient will be notified by February or September based on Spring or Fall submission.
9. If the recipient chooses not to accept the scholarship, NM Vegetation Management Association must be notified in writing by March or October based on spring or fall application..
